continued for years cleaning and picking up the trays. "A steady guy he was, always there," Glen said.

Glen says Reuben was very spiritual and faithful in his Christian life. When they worked in the Rec. Hall, Reuben talked quite a bit about his family and his kids' accomplishments. "He was a proud and loving parent, a family guy, and a good friend and buddy," Glen says.
