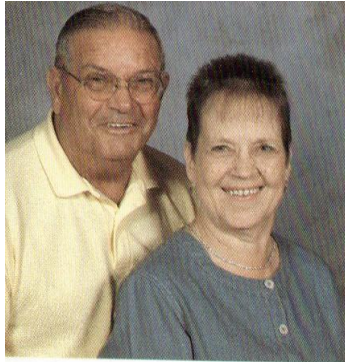


Merrill (Skip) Hall
