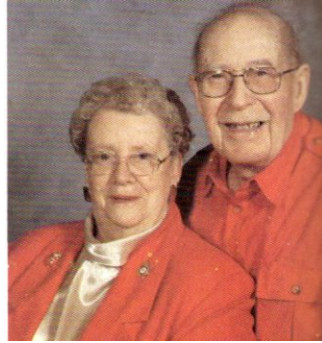


In loving Memory of John "Jack" Stuart Hamilton
