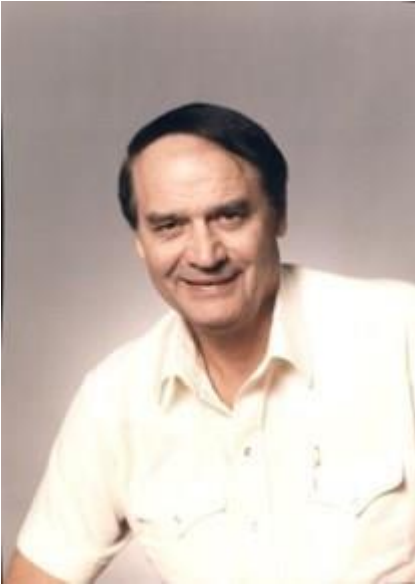


Clarkson J. Mayhew, Jr.
